Background

Kathmandu University (KU), Dhulikhel, Kavre was established in 1991 (2048 B.S) to provide higher education and research in different disciplines at all levels through the Schools of Arts, Education, Engineering, Law, Management, Medicine, and Science. The Department of Management Informatics and Communication (MIC), a multidisciplinary Department, is an extension of the University's School of Management (SoM) at the University's main campus in Dhulikhel. The Department runs the Bachelor of Business Information Systems (BBIS) program of SoM and the Masters of Philosophy (MPhil) in English Language Education program of School of Education and monitors the management- and communication-related courses in School of Engineering, School of Science and School of Law.

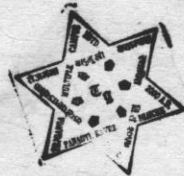

Terms of the Agreement

- MIC/KU and TMC will support each other with the sole aim of nurturing, developing and consolidating all aspects of humanities, management and education in Kavre.
- MIC/KU and TMC will extend full cooperation in the training of each other's students in the Undergraduate and Graduate programs.
- MIC/KU will support TMC in the aspect of faculty development through training, workshops and joint research projects.
- MIC/KU will accommodate in the Research Support/Fellowship program 1 (one) M Phil or 1 (one) PhD candidate from the humanities, education and management faculties of TMC each year in the condition that the candidate(s) meet the eligibility standards of KU programs and KU has relevant quotas in the M Phil and PhD programs.
- TMC will provide MIC/KU venue for any short-term community-based initiatives; and for any future extension programs through new agreements on the modalities of resource management.


Duration of the Agreement

- The LOA will be effective for 5 (five) years immediately from the day it is signed. The LOA can be extended after five years if both sides agree to do so.
- Any changes, revisions and modification will be considered by mutual agreement.

Termination of the Agreement




